beginning at the Sandhorough focus at the
Northwest corner of the Sandhorough to George
Hill on North Sandhorough & a line runs so running

small lower community known by the name of Cartwrights
half way the Southern side of the said Hill or River to
the Southernmost bounds of Rowden in the said New

saw it.
